The 23rd Golf Challenge Raises \$133,108.50 – Surpasses a Cumulative Total of \$2 Million Dollars!!!!

Having begun in 1999, this was the 23rd Annual Golf Challenge. That first year, 58 fundraiser golfers brought in \$41,474.65 and two sponsors donated a total of \$1,500 for an event total of \$42,974.65. We've come a long way since then, considerably increasing the number of sponsors even as the number of fundraiser golfers has decreased. And yet these dedicated fundraiser golfers, many of whom come back year after year, do a superb job of inspiring others to donate to the mission of serving seniors. We are also always delighted to welcome new fundraiser golfers each year.

Despite the heat, we had a wonderful day on June 7 at the Bucknell Golf Club. After being greeted by staff with a gift bag full of goodies and being reminded that the funds raised through the event would benefit residents at RiverWoods and Normandie Ridge, and participants in the Albright LIFE programs, a total of 56 golfers hit the links at 9 am.

When the golfers completed 18 holes, they came into the clubhouse for a delicious dinner at 2 pm, followed by a presentation of the awards for winning golfing contests and their amazing fundraising success.

Golfers, volunteers, and associates at the Golf Challenge gathered to hear remarks from Shaun Smith, President, Albright Care Services/Integrated Services; JD Shuman, President & CEO, Asbury Foundation; Fran Ashby, VP, Donor Relations & Philanthropy, Asbury Foundation; and Sue Jamison, Donor Relations & Community Outreach, Asbury Foundation.
