
Albright Pharmacy will work directly with your physician, insurance, and current pharmacy to obtain all necessary orders, authorizations, and prescriptions. We use innovative software that helps ensure medication accuracy, and also makes it easy to transfer prescriptions to any other pharmacy.

If you are interested in Albright Pharmacy refilling your prescription medications so you do not have to leave campus, please note the following:

- Residents should NOT physically visit the pharmacy due to the current pandemic protocols in place. All needed information can be obtained via the telephone.
- When you are down to a one week supply of your medication, call Albright Pharmacy at 570-522-3108. They will work with you and your current pharmacy to have your prescription transferred to Albright Pharmacy.
- Ridgecrest Apartment residents: Your medications will be dropped off at the Ridgecrest front desk. The Ridgecrest receptionist will contact you when your medication is available for pick-up.
- Cottage Residents: Your medications will be delivered to you by the pharmacy and left in the door or in your mailbox.
- The pharmacy cannot guarantee same-day medications.
- Albright Pharmacy cannot guarantee that they will be able to fill all medication requests. In the event that the pharmacy is unable to fill a medication, you will be notified immediately.
