Dear Kindley Assisted Living Family Members,

On Tuesday, July 28th, we were notified that an associate who works in Kindley Assisted Living tested positive for COVID-19. We have implemented our protocols, including our contact tracing process, and are working in coordination with the Asbury Communities Operations Team and the Montgomery County Department of Health (DOH) to ensure all measures are taken for the safety of those who live and work in Kindley.

We have already notified family members of residents identified through our contract tracing that require quarantine as a precaution.

Outdoor visitation will be suspended per DOH requirements and will not resume until Tuesday, August 4th. Celia Nathan will be reaching out to those of you currently on the visitation calendar to ensure your visit is appropriately rescheduled.
