Dear Residents, Family Members, and Associates,

By now, you have all heard me refer to our reopening as a “dimmer switch” which we would dial up slowly over time. Tonight, however, we are being asked to turn the dimmer switch back down, temporarily. The office of the County Executive has just issued a new Executive Order with guidelines addressing the recent rise in COVID-19 cases in Montgomery County. We ask for your continued partnership in keeping each other safe by following all recommended guidelines and maintaining our vigilance during these winter months.

As of 5 p.m. today, the following changes are in effect for Montgomery County. Compliance with these rules will have an impact on some of our campus activities:

- Worship services are restricted to 25% of room capacity. This includes volunteers and faith leaders. Every other row must remain empty.

- Dining rooms are restricted to 25% of capacity, and home delivery of meals is recommended.
- All theatres must close. We will continue to show movies and events on AVTV, but movies will not be shown in Rosborough theatre at this time.
- Based on the executive order restricting social clubs for senior centers, AMV room reservations will not be allowed for any social gatherings or meetings, and we ask that you refrain from gathering for card clubs or other events right now. If you have a meeting scheduled on campus, please plan to hold a virtual or telephone meeting instead. We will be happy to provide support as needed.
- Any other gatherings not mentioned above: Limited to 1 person or household per 200 sq. ft. or a maximum of 25 people, whichever number is lower. Social distancing must be maintained.

The following campus services will continue with our current precautions:

- Our campus hair salons will remain open by appointment only; all staff are to wear gloves and any other PPE as appropriate.
- Bargain Mart & Clothes Closet can remain open with current restrictions in place.
- Our fitness center and pool will remain open at 25% capacity.
- Kindley Assisted Living and Wilson Health Care Center will remain restricted to window visits only at this time.

Ensuring that we provide a safe and healthy environment for those who work and live at our communities is our highest priority, and we appreciate your patience as we implement the changes needed to accommodate this new Montgomery County Executive Order. As a reminder, be diligent about wearing your masks, washing your hands for 30 seconds (not 10!), and maintaining 6 feet of space with others. We are Asbury Strong!
