A Message from the Executive Director

Dec. 11, 2020

Dear Residents, Family Members & Associates,

As we should expect, our approach to addressing the COVID-19 pandemic continues to evolve as we place the highest priority on the health and safety of those who live and work here. You may already be aware that on Thursday, Pennsylvania Gov. Tom Wolf issued new COVID-19-related safety orders that will impact Bethany Village. The orders go into effect at 11:59 p.m. tonight and focus on temporarily closing in-person dining and indoor wellness classes. As of now, Gov. Wolf says the order is in effect for three weeks -- through Jan. 4, 2021.

Here's what is changing:

- **In-person dining is suspended.** We will continue to offer delivery and take-out options, please see the info below for details:
 - Springfield's will be closed to in-person dining starting tomorrow, Saturday, Dec. 12. The Café will remain open for take-out or pickup

options. Delivery options continue to be available (no delivery fee). Starting on Dec. 21, we will go back to having both lunch and dinner options (two options for each meal) for delivery. Residents will also be able to order a continental breakfast. Delivery times (after Dec. 21) will be 11:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. We will also be able to deliver milk and bread if needed. Weekend deliveries will be at noon. We will have a special menu for Christmas, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. The café will be closed on Christmas Day and New Year's Day. If you should have any dining questions, you can reach out to Dustin Goss at 717-591-8323.

- **The wellness center will also be temporarily closed.** This means no indoor wellness, fitness or aquatics classes or open gym or pool times. Outdoor classes may be held. If you have any Wellness questions, please reach out to Justin Margut at 717-591-8368. We will continue to closely monitor this for any updates and changes.
- The state order also limits in-person gatherings to 10 people. This restriction does not impact us. As a reminder: the max gathering size for in-person visits is 4 people per home in Residential Living, and mask wearing and physical distancing are always required. While this is not an ideal situation, we are supportive of these new measures to help mitigate the transmission of COVID-19. The recent uptick in COVID-19 cases across our area and the entire country is concerning and we must do our part, as a community, by following these safety precautions.

Bethany Village associates remain committed to their sacred work in serving you and your fellow residents. And we need you to do the same. Remember, we are all in this together. Please continue to follow the 3 W's:

1. Wear Masks
2. Wash Hands

3. Watch Distance
