A Message from the Executive Director

Dear Residential Living Residents, Family Members & Associates,

As we should expect, our approach to addressing the COVID-19 pandemic continues to evolve as we place the highest priority on the health and safety of those who live and work here. You may already be aware that on Thursday, Pennsylvania Gov. Tom Wolf issued new COVID-19-related safety orders that will impact Asbury Springhill. The orders go into effect at 11:59 p.m. tonight and focus on temporarily closing in-person dining and indoor wellness classes. As of now, Gov. Wolf says the order is in effect for three weeks -- through Jan. 4, 2021.

Here's what is changing:

- **In-person dining is suspended.** We will continue to offer delivery and take-out options, please see the info below for details:
 - Complimentary delivery will be available while the dining room is temporarily closed. Please call 814-860-7014 to place an order, or feel free to come down to the bar area if you prefer to place your order in person. Continental breakfast will continue to be available

for pick up at the bar 7 days a week.

- **The wellness center will also be temporarily closed.** This means no indoor wellness, fitness or aquatics classes or open gym or pool times. We will, however, be offering exercise classes on our in-house cable channel (Ch. 108) for all exercise classes as regularly scheduled.
- **Springhill will be suspending all gatherings out an abundance of caution.** We will continue to monitor the activity around us to determine how long this might need to remain in effect. This includes, but is not limited to, Current Events, cards, billiards, ping-pong, religious services, and exercise classes. One-on-one activities such as the salon and massage may continue as long as each person is wearing a mask and washing their hands. As the weather allows, please get outside and enjoy the fresh air with a walk, or stay indoors and walk through the hallways and common areas – but please do not congregate.

While this is not an ideal situation, we are supportive of these new measures to help mitigate the transmission of COVID-19. The recent uptick in COVID-19 cases across our area and the entire country is concerning and we must do our part, as a community, by following these safety precautions.

Springhill associates remain committed to their sacred work in serving you and your fellow residents. And we need you to do the same. Remember, we are all in this together. Please continue to follow the 3 W's:

1. Wear Masks
2. Wash Hands
3. Watch Distance
