

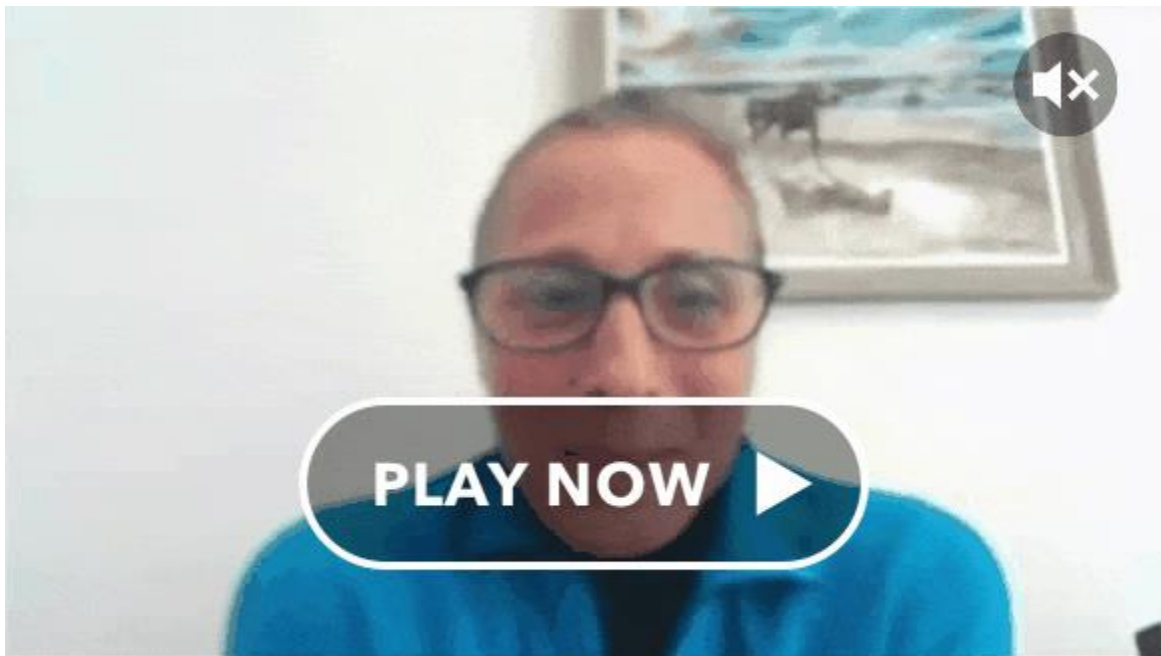

## Save the Date! COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic for RL Residents

Yes, the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine is coming to Residential Living residents at Asbury Methodist Village.

**Thanks to our partners at Holy Cross Health, AMV will offer a three-day vaccine clinic in the Rosborough Center on February 1, 2, and 3.** Over the next two weeks, complete details will be communicated in a series of emails, flyers, post cards, and more. Please watch out for these communications and

thanks for your patience as we formalize the details.

**Quick facts:**

- The vaccine clinic will be for any Residential Living resident 65 years and older – this is a limit placed by the state of Maryland and cannot be waived for any resident under 65. We encourage those under 65 to [monitor updates by the state of Maryland](#) regarding availability of the vaccine to other age groups.
- The clinic will be held in the Rosborough Center. Extensive campus transportation options will be provided on those days. Vaccines will only be provided at the clinic location and times; vaccines can not be provided in one's home so please plan accordingly if you need assistance to attend.
- In order to receive the vaccine, residents will need to first register online with the state. Information on how to do this will be provided to you as soon as possible in a separate communication.
- Residents will be assigned a window of time to attend. Detailed information will be provided to you about what day and time to attend.
- **This clinic is for residents only.** Associates, private duty aides and family members are not included in this vaccination event. (Asbury is helping to facilitate future vaccination opportunities for associates.)
- Anyone in quarantine or isolation due to virus exposure cannot be vaccinated or attend the clinic due to the safety precautions we must put into place. Please continue to protect yourself from exposure for the next two weeks by limiting your access to others who may put you at risk.
- This is scheduled to be our **only** Residential Living vaccine clinic for the first dose. The second dose will be available 28 days later. You must get the second dose for the vaccine to work.
- We want you to be informed about the vaccine, how it will help in our overall fight to keep our community safe, and what you can expect. [Please click here to view a webpage with detailed information](#), including Frequently Asked Questions.
