## A Message from Executive Director Brian Grundusky

Dear Residential Living Residents & Family Members,

I have some great news to share today! The Moderna COVID-19 vaccine is coming to Residential Living residents at Bethany Village.

***We have partnered with Care Options Rx to provide Residential Living residents the opportunity to receive the vaccine during clinics slated for Feb. 7 and Feb. 8 here at Bethany Village (details below).*** We have been exhaustive in our efforts to offer this opportunity for Residential Living residents, and this clinic follows the COVID-19 vaccine clinic that was recently held for The Oaks Skilled Nursing and one that is scheduled for early February for MapleWood Assisted Living. We are pleased to be able to serve you and your fellow residents in maintaining health and safety through the offering of the COVID-19 vaccine.

**Residential Living residents: Here's what you need to know**

- The vaccine clinics are open for any Residential Living resident at Bethany Village.
- **Mark your calendar!** Here are the clinic details, which are broken down for each side of campus:
  - ***Clinic for East Campus Residents:***
    - **When: 9 a.m. - 5 p.m., Feb. 7** (*you will be assigned an appointment time*)
    - **Where: Richard D. Rife Center**
  - ***Clinic for West Campus Residents:***
    - **When: 9 a.m. - 5 p.m., Feb. 8** (*you will be assigned an appointment time*)
    - **Where: West Multipurpose Room (by the Clinic)**
- **In preparation for the vaccine clinics, you will receive a call from a Bethany Village associate the week of Jan. 25 (next week).** The associate will share additional details with you about the vaccine event.
- **All Residential Living residents will receive a COVID-19 Vaccine Consent Form in your mailbox.** If you wish to receive the vaccine, please complete and return the form to the East Front Desk or West Front Desk. ***Form submission deadline is: January 29.***
- **We will assign each resident a time for your vaccine clinic appointment.** Please plan for 60 minutes for your appointment, which includes an observation period following the shot being administered. You will also be given a Vaccine Card that notes your first shot, please hang onto this documentation.

- Vaccines cannot be provided in one's home so please plan accordingly if you need assistance to attend.
- **As you may know, the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine requires two doses 28 days apart.** You must get both doses for the vaccine to work. The second dose is scheduled for March 7 and March 8. We will share details in advance of that clinic.
- Anyone in quarantine or isolation due to virus exposure cannot be vaccinated or attend the clinic due to the safety precautions we must put into place. Please continue to protect yourself from exposure by limiting your access to others who may put you at risk.
- Bethany Village associates will also have the opportunity to receive the vaccine during this clinic.
- We want you to be informed about the vaccine, how it will help in our overall fight to keep our community safe, and what you can expect. Please [click here to view a webpage](#) with detailed information, including Frequently Asked Questions.
