Kindly Assisted Living Visitation

Dear KAL Residents and families,

After many long months, we are pleased to begin offering in-person visits with your loved ones at Kindly Assisted Living. We are implementing careful health and safety requirements in making these in-person visits available, and we thank you in advance for your partnership in keeping our community as safe as possible. Here's what you need to know about visitation:

- All in person visits will take place in the 1st floor living room.
- Visits will be limited to two visitors per resident and 30 minutes (no exceptions).
- All visitors must be 18 years or older.
- Those seeking an in person visit will have to provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test that was taken within 72 hours of the visit. This will apply to every in-person visit. We ask for your understanding as this is for the safety of all Kindly residents.
- A staff person must be present throughout the visit to monitor safety requirements.

These are the days and times that visitors may schedule an in-person visit:

Tuesdays: 10am to 2pm

Thursdays : 1pm to 4:00pm

Fridays: 11am to 4:00pm

Saturdays: 10:30 am to 4:00PM

Window Visits will remain available by scheduled appointments and will take place on Mondays, Wednesdays and Sundays.

We will continue to offer Face Time and Zoom visits as we always have.

We ask for your patience and understanding as we work to staff a variety of visitation formats now. We will do our best to accommodate your very important family time with your loved one.
