Kindley Assisted Living Visitation

Dear KAL Residents and families,

As we have learned throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, we must remain ready to adapt quickly in order to best provide for the health and safety of those we serve. Today is a day in which we must adapt quickly.

Our recent round of state-required COVID-19 testing detected at least one new positive case of COVID-19 within Kindley Assisted Living. **Therefore, by state safety regulations, we are required to close in-person visitation. We know this news comes on the heels of having just reopened for in-person visitation earlier this week, and we thank you for your patience and understanding as we make this change effective as of today, Feb. 24.** It is important to remember that as long as the virus is present in our state and county, the possibility will always exist that in-person visitation will need to open and close according to periodic cases detected.

We will proceed with monitoring and testing Kindley residents and associates in line with our established procedures. We will share additional updates regarding visitation opportunities as soon as we are able.
