

Residential Living Pet Visitation Policy

- All individuals wishing to enter the Asbury Solomons Community with a visiting pet must complete the screening process at the Community Center to receive a visitor wristband.
- Pets are not permitted to visit the Health Care or Assisted Living communities at this time.
- All pets must meet the requirements of the Asbury Pet Policy and are permitted to interact with only the resident(s) they are visiting.
 - Pets must be up to date on all vaccinations. Pet owner must be able to present this information from a veterinarian upon request during their campus visit.
 - Certificate of Good Health
 - Vaccinations and expiration dates:
 - Rabies
 - Distemper
 - Hepatitis
 - Parainfluenza
 - Parvovirus
 - Bordatella
- Pets will be kept 6 feet away from residents and associates not participating in the visit.
- Pets must always be on a leash and under the control and supervision of the pet's owner while on campus. Leash length will be no greater than three (3) feet.
- All must wash or sanitize their hands before and after having contact with the visiting animal.
- All should not handle leashes, toys, treats, or any other item that goes into the pet's mouth or could have been handled by multiple people.
- The pet handler will prevent animals from licking any person whenever possible.
- Pet owners are responsible for and must properly clean up and dispose of any animal waste indoors and outdoors.
- Pets are prohibited from visiting any dining venues to include the C-Store for any reason.
- No animal shall visit while in estrus (heat), while it has visible parasites or obvious signs of illness which would pose a problem to others.
- If a visiting pet poses a threat or nuisance to the residents, associates or other visitors because of age, size, odor, sound, health or behavioral characteristics, including unsanitary or unprovoked aggressive or threatening behavior the pet will be required to leave the community.
