Guest Meals: Friends and family are welcome at any meal. Charges are billed through the monthly service fee to the host resident.

Resident Programs: Currently, there are small group resident programs/activities. One-on-one sessions with our Activities Department are available.

Appointments: Follow-up appointments are scheduled by The Oaks associates.

Transportation: Transportation to appointments is provided by a variety of service providers. The transportation department can assist with choosing the appropriate method of transportation and vendor.

Social Services: The Social Work Department will work with you and your loved one to set up a care plan meeting to discuss discharge, progression of rehabilitation, nursing updates, etc.

Leaving the Health Care Center: Your safety is very important. Please notify your nurse before leaving the building.

Laundry: Laundry services are available and are included in the daily rate. If you wish to have Bethany Village do your laundry, please bring all personal clothing in need of labeling to your nurse/caregiver. A laundry professional will label each piece of your clothing (including socks and undergarments) and return them to you within 24 hours. Soiled laundry is picked up daily from each neighborhood, clean laundry is delivered to The Oaks on Tuesday and Thursdays.

Resident Mail: Staff promptly delivers mail after receipt from the U.S. Postal Service. Social Security or pension checks, bills, etc., may be rerouted to a responsible party if desired. Outgoing mail may be sent out at the front desk.

Television/Telephone: Provided in all health care rooms.

Internet: WiFi is available in all rooms. Please connect to BVGUEST Network. No password is required.

Tipping: Our associates appreciate compliments but may not accept tips and gifts.

COVID-19 Safety & Updates: For COVID-19 updates, please enroll in our Family emails, which you can access at BethanyVillage.org/ Events & Resources/Family & Friends.

» We follow CDC recommendations and CMS regulations to mitigate infections, including COVID-19. COVID Vaccine & Treatment: If we are offering a clinic during your stay with us you will able to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. We work with healthcare providers to offer the latest COVID-19 treatments as available and indicated.

At Asbury Communities, we are committed to your health and wellness and will support you to follow the recommended adult immunization schedule. We can also provide additional info about any of the recommended vaccinations. Let us know how we can help!

Vaccination is one of the most convenient and safest preventive care measures available. It is important for adults to keep their vaccinations up to date because immunity from childhood vaccines can wear off over time. You may also be at risk for different diseases as an adult or need additional vaccines due to health conditions, job requirements, lifestyle or travel. Talk to your healthcare professional about other recommended vaccines and which vaccines are right for you.

About the COVID-19 vaccine

General side effects of vaccinations are:

Tiredness Muscle pain Nausea

Headaches Chills Allergic reaction

Pain, redness or swelling in the vaccinated extremity

Side effects are generally limited the first few days following the vaccine. To alleviate any side affects you may experience, drink plenty of fluids and move your vaccinated extremity often to prevent soreness.
